



Disclosure of Campus Security Policy & Crime Statistics (Jeanne Clery

Act)

- c. The number of crimes of the type listed in Paragraph 1.a (above) and other crimes involving bodily injury to any person in which the victim is intentionally selected because of the actual or perceived race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, or disability of the victim that are reported to the College's security personnel or local police agencies. Such crimes will be collected and reported according to category of prejudice.
2. For purposes of reporting the statistics with respect to the crimes described above, the College will distinguish, by categories, criminal offenses that occur:
 - a. on campus
 - b. in or on a non-campus building or property
 - c. on public property
 - d. in dormitories or other on-campus residential facilities for students on Campus
3. The statistics for the report will be compiled in accordance with the definitions in the Uniform Crime Reporting System as used by the Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the Hate Crime Statistics Act. The report will not identify victims or individuals accused of crimes.
